#### CHAMPIONING SAFE PRACTICES IN INFUSION MANAGEMENT



The President of MNA Ms Mariam Madhar Ali and the Deputy President Ms Sharipah Asiah Syed Junid Aljunid represented MNA to the CNMF 22nd Biennial meeting on 11th March 2016 which was held at the Royal College of Nursing at 20, Cavendish Square, London, UK., followed by the 3rd Commonwealth Nurses and Midwives Conference on the 12th & 13th March 2016 held at the Royal College of Physicians, Regent Park, London, UK.

CNMF members from Malaysia ,Australia, Bahamas, Botswana, Cook Islands, Cyprus, Ghana, Jamaica, India, , Malta, Sierra Leone, South Africa, Rwanda, Tanzania, Trinidad and Tobago, and the United Kingdom attended the Biennial Meeting. Ms Cecelia Anim, President of the Royal College of Nursing (RCN) who hosted the CNMF Biennial, welcomed delegates to the RCN and officially opened the proceedings.

The 3rd Commonwealth Nurses and Midwives Conference with the theme Toward 2020: Celebrating Nursing And Midwifery Leadership to mark the bicentennial of the birth of Florence Nightingale and the WHO decade for a healthy world. The conference focused on the outstanding and innovative nursing and midwifery leadership in the Commonwealth countries where nurses and midwives provide care in the following areas: clinical practice research and innovation, education and training, policy, management, legislation and regulation.
